

WHAT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED TO RESIDENTS?

Leaf and Limb Pick Up

Yard Waste will be collected weekly according to location. The City of Watkinsville Street Department provides this service. Guidelines are as follows:

- Pickup is limited to a reasonable amount.
- Place limbs and leaves in separate piles by the curb. The leaf vacuum cannot pick up anything but leaves, so please do not include rocks or sticks in your leaf piles.
- Limbs should be 4 inches or less in diameter and no more than 8 feet long. Trim branches so limbs can be fed directly into the chipper.
- Logs and branches over 4 inches in diameter or longer than 8 feet cannot be handled by the City.
- The City will not be responsible for removal of trunks or limbs from trees cut by private contractors. Leaf and Limb service is provided to the homeowner's as a courtesy by the City.
- The City will not be responsible for removal of dirt, building materials, or stump grindings.

All yard waste must be at the curb or roadside within 5 feet by 7:00 a.m. on the collection day. Very Important - yard waste will not be collected if placed in plastic bags. Please do not block storm drains and gutters. The collection schedule for leaf and limb pickup is provided below. Inclement weather and holidays can affect this schedule. Call City Hall at 706.769.5161 for adjusted schedule.

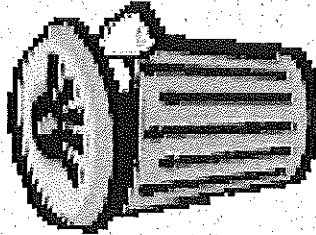
Tuesday: Bunny Hop Tr, Cedar Cir, First St (N of Whitehall), Second St (N of Whitehall), Third St (N of Whitehall), Thrasher Dr, White Ln, White St

Wednesday: Christian Lake, Dooly St, Harden Hill Rd, Jackson St, Lee St, Main St (Hwy 441)

Thursday: Barnett Shoals Rd, Calls Creek, Colham Ferry Rd, Depot St, Farmview Dr, First St (S of Whitehall), Industrial Park, Jeremy Dr, Katie Lane, Lawanna Dr, McRee St, Morrison St, Second St (S of Whitehall), Simonton Pl, Spring Cir, Stone Shoals Subdivision, Taylor's Landline, Third St (S of Whitehall), Whitehall Rd

Garbage

Each resident is to place their household garbage in secured plastic bags and containers with lids no larger than 32 gallon. Your collection day is Wednesday. Please bag all garbage before placing it into any container. The containerized and any additional bagged garbage should be placed no further than 5 feet from the curb or roadside before 7:00 a.m. on the collection day. Return garbage containers to your property and off the city right of way within 24 hours of pick-up.



Please call **CURBSIDE SERVICES, INC.** if you experience service problems, or if you have questions about what services are provided.

Place your garbage carts within five (5) feet of the curb or roadside by 7 AM each collection day.

How Does the County's Recycle Program Work?

Oconee County has 6 recycling centers placed throughout the County. The closest centers to Watkinsville are:

- 2001 Greensboro Hwy (State Rte 15)
 - Rankin Road across from OCMS
- Hours of Operation are: M, W, F 7 am - 6 pm
Sat 8 am - 4 pm
Sun 1 pm - 5 pm

The recycling centers accept:

- Aluminum-beverage cans only, rinsed.
- #1 and #2 plastics - discard caps. No plastic bags.
- Glass-rinsed with lids discarded. No mirrors, plate glass, dishes, or light bulbs.
- Newspapers-keep dry, include inserts. No office paper.
- Corrugated cardboard and brown grocery bags- flatten empty, clean, dry boxes. No drink cartons or frozen food boxes.
- Magazines and slick catalogs-Keep dry. No junk mail or paperback books.
- Phone books and Christmas trees.
- Steel cans-Rinse, labels ok. No paint, gas or kero sente cans.

Please rinse out all food containers. Motor oil can be recycled at the Rankin Road facility. Please, no paint, gas or kerosene cans. If you would like more information on recycling, please call the Oconee County Clean & Beautiful Commission at 706.769.5120.

Holiday Schedule

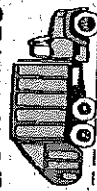
Curbside Services, Inc. observes three (3) major holidays during the year:
